

Being an apprentice is a great way to learn stained glass at no cost. The minimum commitment is 6 hours a week for 3 months. It can be 2 or 3 hour sessions, 2 or 3 times a week. You will learn stained glass techniques while working on projects I've selected, and the completed work remains my property. It is an exchange of learning for labor. A benefit of the apprenticeship is that should you want to build your own work, I will offer guidance, you have access to my well-equipped studio, and the materials you use are highly discounted. Personal projects are done once the weekly apprentice hours are fulfilled. I have had apprentices of all ages and experience levels, and some have been with me for years.
